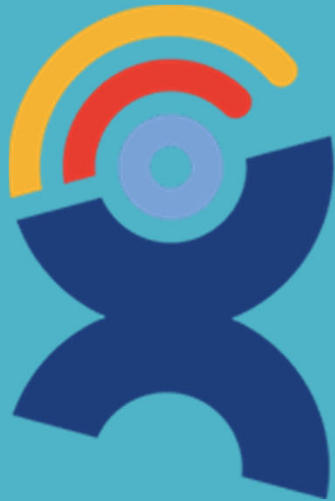

- The Children's Resource Center offers a variety of classes for children aged 0-6. Sample classes include American Sign Language (ASL), infant massage, literacy/ language skill development, and more!

- Developmental screeners are available at this location. If you are concerned about your child's development, or you are noticing signs of developmental delay, please speak with Ms. Amber about options to have your child observed.
- The Center offers a variety of resources for parents as well, including tax preparation, financial stability classes, and breastfeeding support groups.

There is even a tent where I can take a break if I am getting upset or need some quiet time.



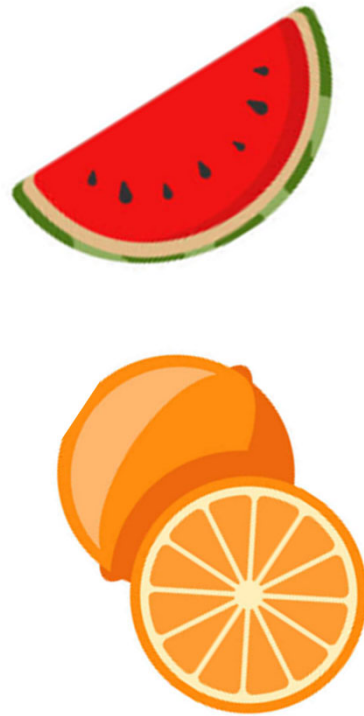


One rule in Ms. Amber's class is only a few friends can be in a area at one time.
