Workplaces can also host an event with the proceeds benefitting United Way of Central Florida. These events also contribute towards their overall donation. Examples include the Judd Jog 5K, Sheriff's Haunted Jail Tour, bake sales, private movie screenings and an adult skate night, to name a few.

What are the UWCF focus areas?



Education

Research shows that children who enter school ready to learn are more likely to graduate high school on time. Statistically, students who graduate high school have a higher chance to find a job that pays a livable wage, live healthier lives, stay out of the judicial system and have children who also graduate high school on time. Through early childhood education partners and Success By 6 programs: The Carol Jenkins Barnett United Way Children's Resource Center, Master Teachers, Parent Lending Library and more, we are creating a world where every child has the opportunity to succeed. UWCF and partners are also working every day to promote academic achievement through tutoring, mentoring and more. *Specific initiatives include Early Childhood Education and Academic Achievement*.

Health

When it comes to accessing health services, a person's zip code should never be a deterrent to success, nor should it be a barrier to improved health. Yet for many, that's a daily reality. By making it easier for individuals to access substance abuse programs, receive quality health care and access nutritious foods, we're working to help everyone get—and stay—healthy.

Financial Stability

United Way addresses a common barrier to building a better future for individuals and our community. Through our partnership providing free tax preparation, 10% of tax prep clients began permanent savings accounts with the goal of supplementing their retirement. UWCF offers budgeting expertise, saving disciplines, and job-skills training to increase income and help families build a better future. Our partners assist families in managing debt and improving their credit, placing individuals on a path to financial independence.

When local residents—no matter their socioeconomic status—are devastated by natural disasters, acts of violence, mental health concerns, homelessness or grief, UWCF and partners provide critical services to help stabilize short-term crises.

VOLUNTEER

A great way to invest in our community is to give your time. There are several ways that individuals can volunteer their time with United Way of Central Florida.



What volunteer opportunities are available?

ReadingPals

ReadingPals is a program managed by United Way of Central Florida that partners with Polk County Public Schools to match reading mentors with four kindergarten students for an hour, once a week. Training is provided and school location is based on your preference.

Healthy Food Pantries

Food Distribution sites around Polk, Hardee and Highlands counties on a variety of days and locations.

Day of Caring Service Projects

Annual service projects allow for your company to connect with our partner agencies to help them with a variety of activities. Projects can even be brought to your company, to be completed on site.

Leadership Giving Association (LGA) Committees

Individuals giving at the LGA level can volunteer on various committees within Women United, Young Leaders Society or Alexis de Tocqueville. These committees help plan events, recruit members, and facilitate service projects.

Community Investment Teams

These volunteers work together to evaluate funding requests. Teams participate in site visits, study applications and assess the effectiveness of services before recommending funding allocations. Community Investment Teams meet once a month for 3-4 months.
